## Which of the following measures would you be **comfortable** with the policing using to maintain compliance with the COVID-19 lockdown?

Roadblocks asking motorists to justify their journeys	59%	54%	62%	61%	70%
Asking people to report others who breach the rules (ie by holding or attending gatherings)	48%	47%	50%	49%	51%
Using drone technology / unmanned aircraft to photograph people making unessential journeys	33%	33%	38%	29%	50%
Analysis of social media accounts (Twitter, Instagram, Facebook etc) to identify those breaching the lockdown	32%	32%	31%	32%	43%
Naming and shaming on social media	22%	25%	22%	17%	38%

Range of opinion: "Comfortable" 67% with roadblocks amongst 35-44s to 16% social media shaming in under 35s
