## Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002

## Request

Please find below our response to your correspondence dated 31 July, in which you made the following request under the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002.

"I request under the above act, to know what monies you have received from Lloyds Banking Group/Bank of Scotland during the past ten (10) years?"

### Response

The Scottish Police Authority does not hold the information requested.<sup>1</sup>

We ran a supplier query in our general ledger system for "Lloyds Banking Group" and "Bank of Scotland". This provided a nil return for any money received in relation to the Authority or Forensic Services.
