ICT advised that the Police Scotland online complaints form will be converted to work on the new system. The new system may now allow an SPA online form to be developed more easily. The SPA Communications Team are liaising with ICT on the new SPA website and will explore options for online forms that can be developed for the SPA.  <b>11.08.2020:</b> The SPA's public facing website was moved onto a more modern and stable content management system on 6 August 2020. ICT have advised that the new software does support an option
